

MATTHEW RUSK



Born in Tucson, Arizona, Matthew received his training at Houston Ballet Academy and the High School for the Performing and Visual Arts, where he graduated with honors in dance. He also spent summers at School of American Ballet, American Ballet Theatre, and the Royal Ballet School. A graduate of Indiana University, he holds a Bachelor of Science in Ballet with an Outside Field in Psychology. While at IU, he was the recipient of the Premier Young Artist Award and the Ken C. Whitener Fund for Ballet Excellence, and performed principal roles in George Balanchine's Emeralds, Four Temperaments, Divertimento No. 15, and Swan Lake, and Marius Petipa's La Bayadere (Kingdom of the Shades). Professionally he joined Cincinnati Ballet in 2015 before transferring to Saint Louis Ballet in 2016, where he is in his seventh season. His repertory at SLB includes Romeo (Romeo and Juliet), Cavalier and Snow King (The Nutcracker), Prince (Cinderella), and principal roles in Balanchine's Who Cares?, Twyla Tharp's Nine Sinatra Songs, and Peter Martins's Hallelujah Junction. He has also guest performed with Nevada Ballet Theatre, Deos Contemporary Ballet, and Houston Repertoire Ballet.

Seyong Kim



Seyong Kim, Associate Professor of Dance at Western Michigan University (Kalamazoo, MI), holds an MA in Dance Education from New York University and an MA in Dance from Sung-Kyun-Kwan University in South Korea. He is a CMA (Certified Movement Analyst), a RSDE (Registered Somatic Dance Educator), a PBT (Progressing Ballet Technique) Certified Teacher, and an ABT® Certified Teacher (Primary through Level 7 of the American Ballet Theatre's National Training Curriculum). Furthermore, he earned the Diversity and Inclusion Certificate from Cornell University. Seyong has taught for the University of Georgia, Rutgers University, Kent State University, Randolph College, Palm Beach Atlantic University, World Dance Alliance-America (WDAA), American College Dance Association (ACDA), Alabama Dance Festival, Nai-Ni Chen Dance Company, Grand Rapids Ballet, Eisenhower Dance Detroit, and Ballet 5:8. Seyong has danced with the Metropolitan Opera in Lincoln Center, Albania National Ballet Theatre, Traverse City Dance Project, TAKE Dance, and Oakland Ballet Company. His choreographic works have been presented at Landestheater Coburg in Germany, Taiwan JueDai Taipei International Dance Festival, International Contemporary Dance Festival of Mexico City (FIDCDMX), ProArteDanza in Canada, Seoul International Dance Festival in TANK, Battery Dance Festival, Palm Desert Choreography Festival, American Dance Guild Festival, Cleveland Dance Festival, Washington International Dance Festival, Detroit Dance City Festival, Boston Contemporary Dance Festival, Orlando Contemporary Dance Choreography Festival, and CrossCurrent Asian American Dance Festival.
